LOCATION:

- Nestled in the Virgin River Valley, 77 miles NE of Las Vegas, Nevada
- Exit 122 off of I-15, just 35 miles SW of St. George, Utah

THE PALMER COURSE:

The Palmer Course, designed by Arnold Palmer, is a magnificent masterpiece in the desert.

This par-71 course offers the golfer a choice of five different tees and some of the most scenic desert panoramas in Southern Nevada. Its rugged canyon fairways and meticulous contour greens set this course apart as one of the best 18 holes you can play.



THE CANYONS COURSE:

The Canyons Course complements the Palmer Course perfectly. Designed by David Druzisky, its fun and dynamic holes weave over stark badlands resulting in a dramatic and memorable round.

The Canyons is rated more difficult than the Palmer course. The front 9 plays like the Palmer Course, however, the back 9 demands length and precision to narrow targets. Every hole is distinct in its features, utilizing every club in your bag.

OASIS GOLF CLUB

The Oasis Golf Club is Mesquite's only semi-private 36-hole golf facility. Arnold Palmer designed the Palmer course for his good friend, Si Redd, opening in 1995. The "Vistas 9" opened at the same time and in 2005 became the back nine of the Canyons.

The Palmer Course is one of Arnold Palmer's top favorite designs! Palmer was quoted in his monthly magazine that #5, #6 & #8 are the top 18 holes he ever designed.

The practice area is the largest in Mesquite. It includes the driving range and a short game practice area complete with putting and target greens. PGA instruction includes private lessons, clinics, and beginner/intro golf classes.

The exquisite and spacious 17,000 square-foot Clubhouse is nestled between the Palmer and the Canyons courses. The Clubhouse includes two dining facilities, each with a fully stocked bar, golf shop, locker rooms, and two members only lounges. The views from the restaurant patio overlook the Virgin Mountains, which border the North Rim of the Grand Canyon.

The Beverage Cart attendants service both courses with hot dogs, snacks, sodas, and adult beverages. Additionally, there is a snack shack on each course. The Palmer Stand is located just after hole 8. The Canyons Snack Shack is located after hole 9. On course food and beverage services are **Cash Only**. There is an ATM located inside the Clubhouse, near the Grille Room Restaurant, and at the Canyons Snack Shack. Water fountains are located outside **ALL** course restrooms

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Is the Oasis Golf Club a member-owned equity club?

- No. The semi-private Club is family owned and operated by the Lee, Green and Copeland families. Members enjoy the Club and facilities without financial responsibilities of a private club.

Who is responsible for the operation of the Club?

- W. Kirk Lee (family member) manages the day-to-day affairs of the Club and Club Facilities.

Can I change my membership category once I purchase it?

- Yes, a member may apply their initial membership fee toward an individual or family golf membership.

Am I allowed to use my own golf cart on the golf course?

- Yes, upon payment of applicable trail fees, proof of insurance and approval by management.

How many members belong to the Club?

- There are approximately 200 memberships, totaling 300 members.

How does the food minimum work?

- Members reach their annual minimum through the use of all Club restaurants, bars, beverage carts and take-out. All food and drinks charged to your account will count. Taxes and gratuity do not count. If the food minimum is not reached at year-end, the member is charged the difference.
